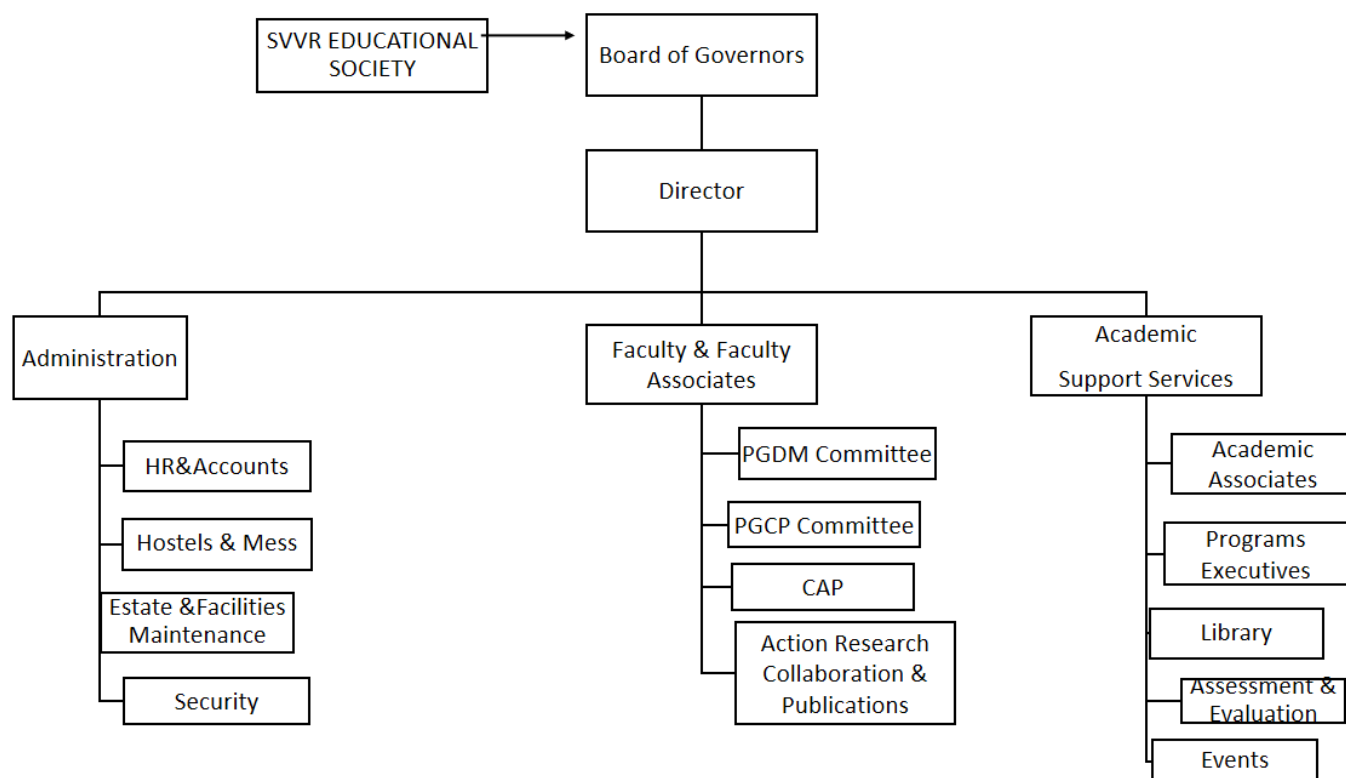

# PGDM (Agri Business Management) Admission Process & Eligibility Criteria

## I. Eligibility

### Essential:

- Graduates from any discipline are eligible, provided they demonstrate a keen interest in Food and Agri Business Management.  
Applicants must have appeared for one of the following entrance exams: CAT, MAT, CMAT, ATMA, GMAT, or XAT.
- A minimum CGPA of 5.00/10.00 or 50% aggregate marks (or equivalent) is required.

### For Final-Year Students:

- Candidates in final year of bachelor's degree should provide GPA/% at least up to third year (in case of four year program) and second year (in case of three-year program).
- Candidates in the final year can apply if they would furnish evidence of meeting the minimum eligibility criteria by September 2026.
- Final year candidates should have appeared in all of their graduation examinations before the start of the program (July 06, 2026).

### Academic Diversity

- SGI-FAB School encourages academic diversity and prefers candidates with a background education and/or work experience in:
  - Agriculture, Horticulture and other allied sectors
  - Dairy Science, Dairy Technology, Veterinary Sciences
  - Food Sciences and Food Technology,
  - Science, Engineering, Commerce
  - Arts and Social Sciences

### Please Note:

- If selected, the candidates failing to meet the minimum eligibility criteria will be asked to withdraw from the programme.
- The Fees paid by such candidates will be forfeited unless SGI-FAB School fills their vacant seats through new admissions.

All other applicants will be placed on a **waiting list** until the completion of the admission cycle.

## III. Admission Process



- Step 1: Registration and Payment of Application Fee; Fill the online registration form
- Step 2: SGI-Food and Agri Business School Aptitude Test conducted online
- Step 3: Personal Interview - Candidates will appear for PI
- Step 4: Selection - Provisional admission will be granted based on merit. The offer letter will be sent via email and post.
- Step 5: Commitment Fee - Pay the commitment fee of Rs 25,000 for confirming provisional admission.

## Post Graduate Diploma in Agri Business Management (PGDM-ABM)

The two-year PGDM (ABM) programme equips students for diverse roles in the Farm, Food and Agribusiness sectors by fostering sustainable enterprise management skills through foundational, functional, integrative management and sector-specific courses; which emphasises theoretical frameworks, analytical tools, and practical skills through immersive learning, preparing students for real-world challenges.

A unique focus on sustainable enterprise management balances the triple ‘P’ objective of ‘Planet’ (ecology), ‘Profit’ (economy), and People (equity) through the following:

A. Induction	B. Interactive Learning	C. Experiential Learning
D. Enterprise Realities	E. Management Internship	F. Capstone Project

A. Induction: 4 weeks

- To enhance computation, comprehension, and IT skills
- To enhance students’ readiness for successful completion (to avoid failures)

B. Interactive Learning: Five terms – 60 weeks – 90 credits

- To learn theoretical frameworks, analytical tools through class room sessions, subject specific assignments and case-study based discussions etc

C. Experiential Learning–Seed to Market Project–spread across 3 terms–4 credits

- To ensure integration of theoretical knowledge with practical application
- To provide practical exposure of business principles
- To inculcate entrepreneurial spirit among students

D. Enterprise Realities – 3 weeks – 4 credits

- To explore the Farm, Food, and Agri Business Enterprises through EEE Exercise, Appreciative Inquiry, Focus Group Discussions, Interviews.
- To collaborate and co-publish encapsulated learning

E. Management Internship – 12 weeks – 12 credits

- To experience the real-work field environment through hand holding
- To evolve and implement sustainable enterprise management solutions
- To collaborate and co-publish encapsulated learning from the internship

F. Capstone Project – Sixth term – 10 weeks – 10 credits



- To explore the Global, National, Regional, Local level sector scenarios in the Farm, Food, and Agribusiness
- To compare, analyse, prepare and present a report on the sector scenario
- To appreciate the role of existing and emerging Technologies in these sectors
- To recognise the importance of ESG in Sustainability Assessment.
- To encourage, prepare and enhance 'Job-readiness'

## Focus of the Programme

1. **Market Orientation:** Agriculture and food industries are currently undergoing significant changes. Professionals in these sectors and farmers have to work in a more market orientated environment in order to fulfil consumer expectations and increasing environmental concerns.
2. **Business & Management Skills:** The programme will equip students with skills, knowledge and attitudes required for a successful manager in the field of agribusiness in the emerging global context.
3. **Blend of Basic and Integrated Courses:** The programme includes basic courses that help students understand the agriculture and agribusiness sector, core courses that develop required analytical and communication skills in the students, courses in functional areas of management, and integrated courses that help students develop strategic perspective.
  - **Rural Exposure:** Will provide first hand insights about field level rural realities.
  - **Summer Project:** Will provide exposure to real-life situations through partnership with industry.
  - **Entrepreneurial Skills:** Unique feature of this programme is to equip entrepreneurial skills to those who want to be job creators rather than job seekers, by setting up agribusiness enterprises, both in India and in other countries.

## Infrastructure Details: 45 - acre campus

The 'Flame of Forest' campus of Sagar Group of Institutions is located at a Chevella town, 45 kilometers from the city of Hyderabad, Telangana. The campus is named after the beautiful 'Flame of Forest' trees that grown in this area. The campus is 50 kms from Rajiv Gandhi International Airport and 50kms from Secundrabad railway station.

'Flame of Forest' is a sprawling 45-acre integrated campus which has been divided into an 18 acres bit comprising of infrastructure such as academic blocks, canteen, library, hostels etc. and a 32 acres bit that is dedicated to farming and field work for students to enable live practical learning.

### Infrastructure

The infrastructure has been designed keeping in mind the requirement of individual institution under SGI. Every institution has a dedicated academic block which comprises of lecture halls, computer labs, language lab etc. The structures have been designed with 'sustainability' and 'creativity' as the primary themes.

### Library

FABS has an excellent and uniquely designed central library. It is well stocked with books and journals both in physical and digital versions. It also boasts of a e learning cell where students have access to IT systems for enhanced digital learning.

### Class Rooms

Specially designed in semi-circular theater format that ensures participative learning, all the classrooms are equipped with latest communication equipment.

### **Business Communication Lab**

FABS has a state-of-the-art Computer Lab. The students will be working in a Wi-Fi enabled networked environment.

### **Hostels**

We believe that students learn as much from their group work and mutual interactions as they learn from the instructors in the classroom. Hence, we have made the programme fully residential. All students are provided with well-furnished single occupancy rooms with common meeting and recreation rooms and coffee dispensing machines. Separate blocks are provided for boys and girls.

### **Canteen**

Most of the innovative learning takes place while having a sip of coffee in a group. To cater to this need, a sprawling canteen with modern kitchen is available with Wi-Fi connectivity. This will be the best part of the campus and the buzzing centre of activity in the campus.

### **Industry Visits**

FABS lays emphasis on experiential learning. Students are taken to industries for real life exposure to business operations which would enable them to get practical experience to live operations. Such visit would help the students apply classroom concepts to real scenarios.

### **Seminar**

Knowledge is free flowing and is owned by no one. Keeping this quote in mind, FABS conducts regular seminars, workshops and guest faculty lectures to facilitate a free flow of ideas and knowledge. It is highly important that the students and faculty get to interact with experts in various fields in the agriculture sector. Seminars and guest lectures also act as a platform for companies to interact with students for future recruitment drives.

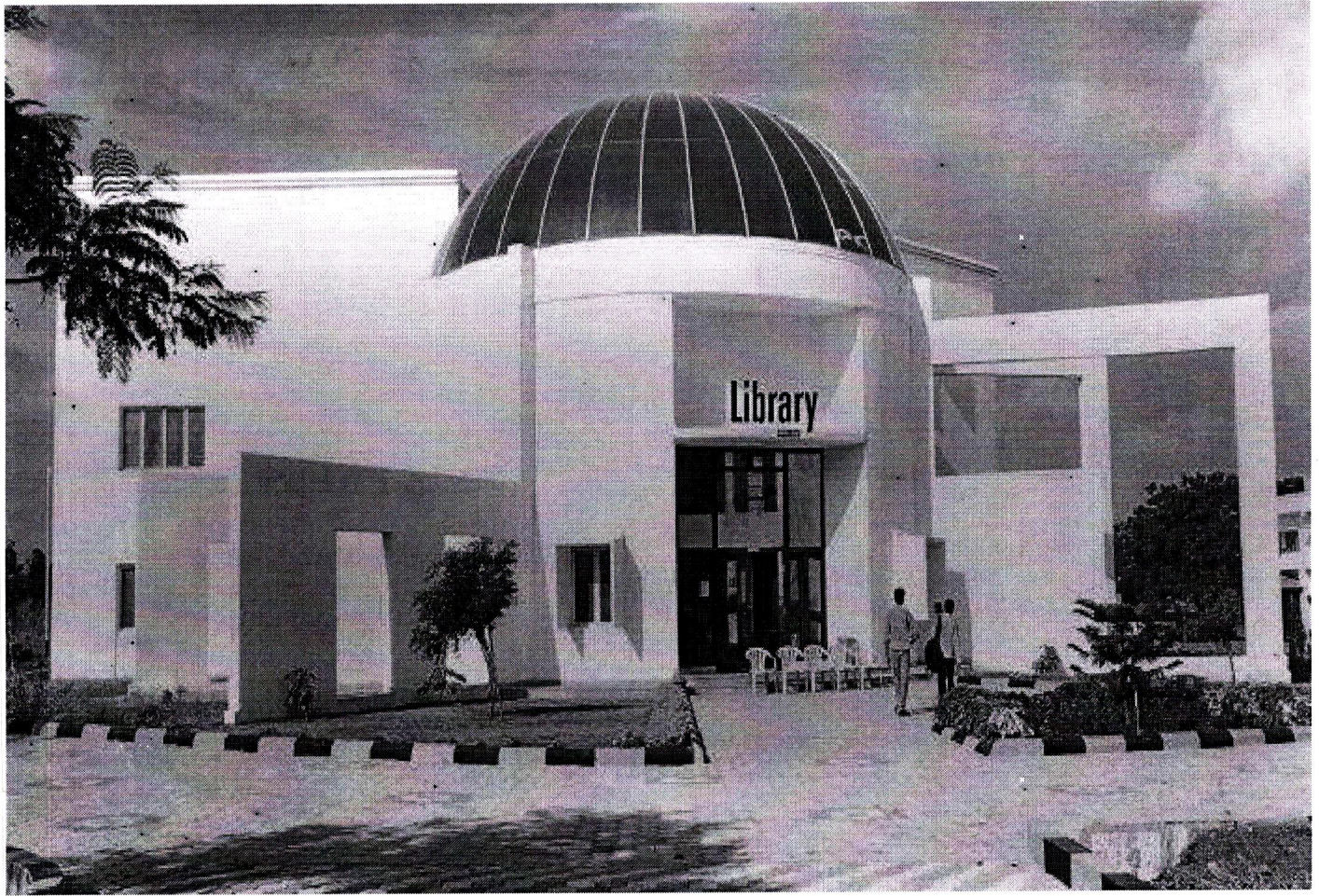
